SPRING CLEAN UP DAYS

MAY 5th & 6th, 2023

City of Philip residents are welcome to bring rubble site acceptable items **FREE** of charge to the City Rubble Site on **Friday, May 5th & Saturday, May 6th** between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (Rain dates: May 19th & 20th)

Residents that do not have the ability or means to haul the acceptable items to the rubble site, shall contact the City Office at 605-859-2175 by May 4th to schedule a pick up time. Items shall be placed as close to the curb or alley as possible **by 7:00 a.m. on Monday, May 8th** for pick up on that day.

The Rubble Site accepts the following items: scrap metal, furniture, mattresses, grass clippings, leaves, tree branches, appliances (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners must be certified that they are freon free!) Those items NOT ACCEPTED FOR FREE include tires, vehicles & construction materials--charges will be assessed if delivered to the rubble site.

Items that can be deposited in your HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE include, but are not limited to: plastic, clothing, televisions, computers and regular household waste. Newspapers & cardboard can also be deposited in the Recycling Dumpsters located at the intersection of E. Oak St. and S. Auto Ave.

All property owners are strongly encouraged to take advantage of these services during Spring Clean Up. Any property which is not cleaned up may be issued a Nuisance Declaration and the property owner will be required to address such issues at their own cost.
